










AVG U.S. OCCUPANCY BY LOCATION







Arrivalist Weekly Index of Road Trips (Base: Feb 2- Feb 29 Avg. Trips)








DOMESTIC AIR TRAVEL








EXCITEMENT FOR TRAVEL









